*Think about a time when you **cooperated**, too. Draw a picture of what happened. Write about it in the lines below.*

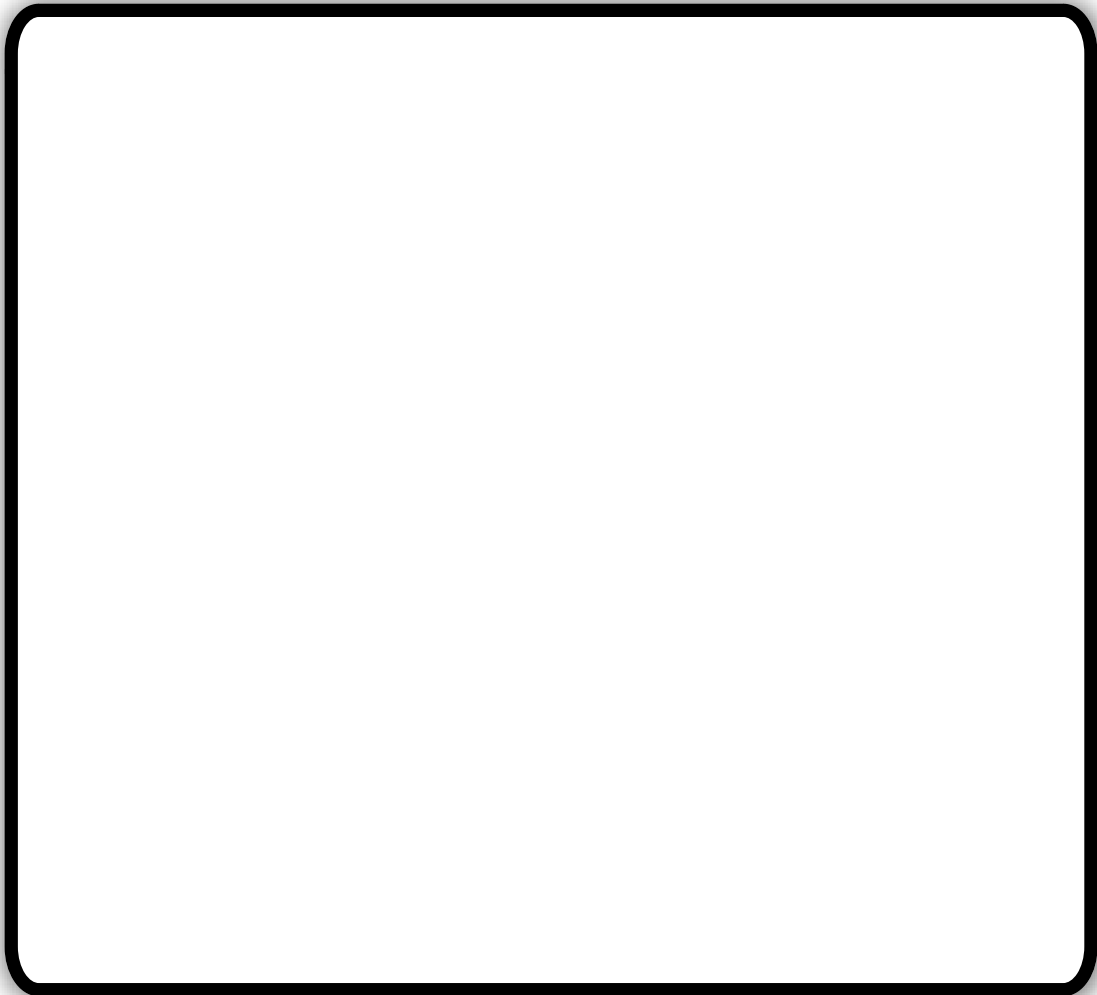
